HELP FOR LIVING — “BATTLES” II Chronicles 20:1-30

FIRST: HE _____ IT TO THE _____.

“Alarmed, Jehoshaphat resolved to inquire of the Lord, and proclaimed a fast for all Judah. The people of Judah came together to seek help from the Lord; Indeed they came from every town in Judah to seek him.” (vs. 3-4)

SECOND: HE _____ HIS _____.

“For we have no power to face this vast army that is attacking us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are upon you.” (v.12)

“I lift up my eyes to the hills, from where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth.” Psalm 121:1-2

THIRD: HE _____ STRONG IN THE _____.

“Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours but God’s.” (v. 15)

“Take your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.” (v. 17)

FOURTH: HE _____ THE _____.

“Jehoshaphat bowed with his face to the ground, and all the people of Judah and Jerusalem fell down in worship before the Lord.” (v. 18)
